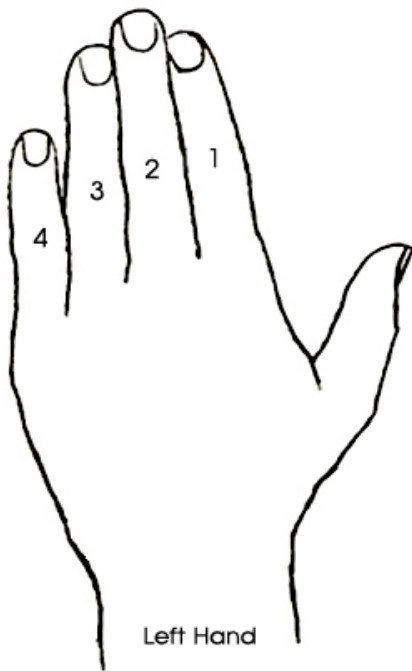


Performance Notes

Though I have put each arrangement into tablature, you will still need to look at the standard notation in order to get the correct fingerings (e.g., 1 = index, 2 = middle, 3 = ring finger, 4 = pinky and O = open). All of the musical expressions and fingerings are based on classical guitar notation. For example: CIII means to barre at the third fret and 1/2CII means to make a half barre (covering the E, A, and sometimes C) strings at the second fret. Also, like standard guitar notation, the pieces are written an octave above the actual notes played. Thus, the low G note begins at the 2nd staff line up from the bottom.
